Psychological Examination of Police Members Who Commit

Disciplinary Violations

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Abstract

One way to improve quality and professionalism is to conduct psychological examinations of members of the National Police who commit disciplinary violations. The results of the study show that psychological examinations are very important to identify the causes of disciplinary violations and increase the awareness and ability of members of the National Police. This study shows that psychological examinations can help restore the psychological condition of police members and ensure that they are professional and honest when making decisions. Therefore, psychological examinations must be carried out professionally, objectively, and integrated with the internal supervision and control system of the National Police.

Introduction

The National Police is a state tool that has a role in maintaining public security and order, enforcing the law and providing protection, protection, and services to the community in order to maintain internal security. Article 13 of Law Number 2 of 2002 concerning the National Police of the Republic of Indonesia shows that the National Police has the main task of maintaining public security and order, enforcing the law to the community. Nugroho (2023) The police need to have various technical abilities, including inevitably having abilities in the field of psychology. Police members are expected to have the ability to act appropriately taking into account the most basic psychological principles.

In practice, several personnel were found to have problems. One of them is personnel in the Police Area. Although in practice every member of the National

Police has actually been obliged to submit to the National Police Regulation Number 2 of 2016 concerning the Settlement of Disciplinary Violations of Members of the National Police of the Republic of Indonesia, but it was found that several personnel experienced problems. In 2019, there were four problematic personnel within the Police. The personnel problems mentioned above are related to violations of member discipline that can lead to the optimization of the implementation of police duties, namely as an institution that must maintain public security and order, enforce the law and provide protection, protection and services to the community. Dewi dkk. (2019)

Psychological coaching is closely related to the mental or soul is the focus of the first attention in exploring the extent of the level of awareness and morality of members of the National Police in exercising the authority mandated by the community through the Law. In addition, this psychological development aims to improve and renew an action or behavior of a member through counseling guidance. In the course of counseling carried out by the psychology section, members of the National Police who serve in the Police must and provide true information, so that in psychological coaching by the psychology section can be in accordance with the real condition of problematic personnel. The phenomenon of psychological examination of police members who commit violations of police discipline is very important in maintaining their professionalism, ethics, and integrity. However, the enforcement of disciplinary regulations for police members is still far from expectations, there are still many undisciplined behaviors, negligence, and other violations. Analyze the mechanism of the strategy for enforcing the discipline of police members in the Metro Jaya Police work unit. The results of the study found that there were members who committed violations involving supporting and inhibiting indicators. Therefore, the strategy of enforcing member discipline must be carried out through the application of strict and severe sanctions in order to provide a deterrent effect.

This can help identify the underlying factors that contribute to the offense, such as personal issues, work-related stress, or other psychological factors (Parameswari (t.t.). There needs to be a comprehensive approach that includes strict and severe sanctions enforcement, as well as addressing the underlying psychological factors that contribute to such violations. By doing this, we can improve the professionalism, ethics, and integrity of police members, which ultimately benefits police institutions and society (Nugroho (2023)).

The purpose of studying psychological examinations of members of the National Police who commit disciplinary violations is, Recognizing the factors that affect the behavior of members of the National Police in committing disciplinary violations. By conducting this research, it can be understood what factors affect the behavior of members of the National Police in committing disciplinary violations, so that appropriate preventive and control measures can be taken. Examining the effectiveness of psychological examinations against members of the National Police who commit disciplinary violations. Psychological examination of violators is one of the efforts to improve discipline and professionalism in police institutions. Psychological examination can be defined as a psychological evaluation process that is carried out to identify the factors that cause disciplinary violations and to determine whether the individual is still a member of the National Police or not. (Bartol, (2002))

In police operations, psychology is used in the development of interrogation technology, traffic control and community guidance. In police organizations, psychology is used to support management and help overcome problems of National Police personnel, personal problems as a result of police duties and stress management for police officers. One part of the police psychology bureau is police psychology as the spearhead of an organization that utilizes applied or applicative psychology to help police operations, such as increasing the capacity of witnesses

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or suspects to conduct case analysis, profiling and autopsy, and helping the

community.

The police is a state tool tasked with maintaining public security and order,

No. 14 of 2011 concerning the Code of Ethics of the Police Professional of the

Republic of Indonesia. Administrative sanctions can be in the form of

recommendations for Dishonorable Dismissal (PTDH) whose handling procedures

are carried out by the provost.

Yogyakarta Police Agency and its ranks have been carried out according to the

stages regulated, starting from reports or complaints, conducting preliminary

disciplinary penalties, implementation of punishments, and finally recording in

Individual Personnel Data.

committed disciplinary violations. This aims to increase the awareness and ability

Violations of disciplinary rules and codes of ethics will be examined, if proven to

be sanctioned. The imposition of disciplinary sanctions and sanctions for violations

of the code of ethics does not remove criminal charges against the police members

concerned. This is regulated in article 12 paragraph (1) of Presidential Regulation

No. 2 of 2003 concerning disciplinary regulations for members of the National

Police. So, even though police members are also civilians, there is a difference in

the investigation process of their cases with ordinary citizens because in addition

to being subject to laws and regulations, police members are also bound by

disciplinary rules and codes of ethics that apply in the institution of the police

which must also be complied with. The settlement of disciplinary violations is

permanent and attached to the superior who is given the authority to apply

punishment, namely the superior who has the right to punish. Superiors have the

authority to give orders to designated criminals to investigate and investigate

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violations of discipline and code of ethics committed by members of the police.

The examination of a case must be based on the existence of a report of arrest or

findings from the officer. A disciplinary action will be given to police members who

have committed a minor disciplinary violation directly given by their superiors

without a disciplinary hearing first, namely punishment. The decision of the

disciplinary hearing is then followed up with a decree by the authorized official

within 30 days and a copy of the decree is submitted to the superior who has the

right to punish.
